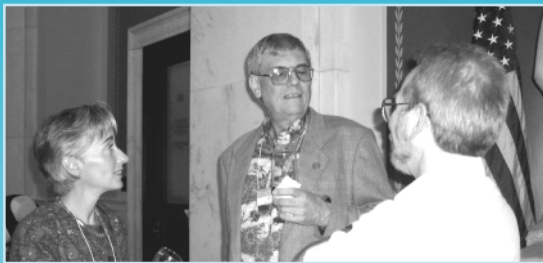

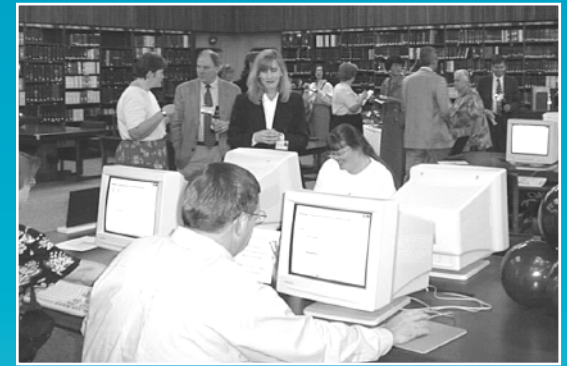

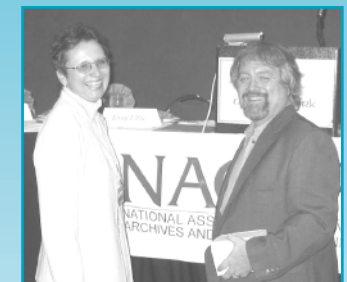

Services

- **Annual meetings** include workshops, papers, and discussion sessions that focus on critical aspects of government records and information management.

- **Clearinghouse**, a quarterly newsletter featuring articles on issues that impact government records programs, keeps members informed about recent developments at the local, state, and federal levels.

- Stay on top of electronic records and information policy issues with **Crossroads**, a quarterly bulletin prepared by the **NAGARA** Committee on Electronic Records and Information Systems (CERIS).

- **NAGARA's** website www.nagara.org is the place to find out about the association's activities, developments in the field, position papers, links to member programs, and other helpful information.

- **NAGARA** addresses issues at all levels of government by nurturing intergovernmental records initiatives, annual surveys, and reports on state government archival and records programs.

- **NAGARA** affiliates and cooperates with other professional organizations such as the National Electronic Commerce Coordinating Council, Council of State Historical Records Coordinators, and the National Coalition for History to produce white papers, position statements, and other resources that advocate priority issues such as the importance of government records and best practices for management of electronic records.
